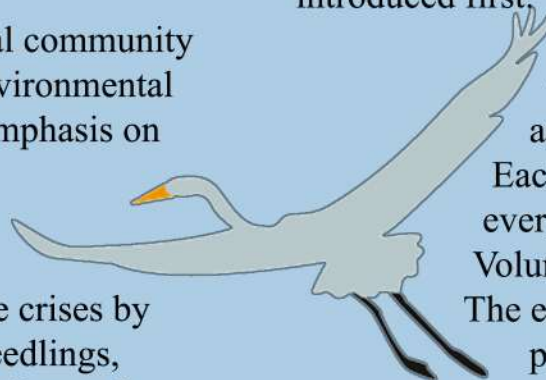

We talk to people who worked for collective and group benefits, created value and influenced wetland climates. In this series of podcasts about wetlands, we will talk specifically about valuable wetlands in Iran and the world, and publish the lived experiences of social activists.

Sabzekaran Institute invites all activists and members of wetland organizations to participate with us in order to spread hope in the society by sharing their activity stories and experiences of trying to restore the wetland.

We believe that these actions, although small, can create motivation, hope and even an active way in the minds of other people.....



In each episode, the wetland and its capacities and damages are introduced first.



Then 2 to 3 activists in the field of the same wetland narrate a story of their activities, experiences and lessons learned.

Each of these stories is narrated in 5 to 7 minutes in everyday language in Farsi or English.

Volunteers must first prepare their text and record it. The edited guide file will be provided to them and the project manager will be by their side all the way.
